
The School Dental Care Service (SDCS) and the Student Health Service (SHS) of the Department of Health are now conducting enrolment exercise for the 2018/ 2019 school term. We would like to invite school children to participate in the services. The service period starts from November 2018 to October 2019.

Students who join School Dental Care Service would be arranged to clinic for their oral checking and therapy. The SDCS will provide a chartered bus service to and from the clinic during school days for the participants. Helpers or parents are required to accompany their children during treatment. Only school children under the age of 18 as at 1st September 2018 are eligible to join the SDCS. Applicants have to pay \$30 for application. Enrolled students may seek emergency service during office hours at Argyle Street Jockey Club School Dental Clinic.

The Student Health Service is provided free. The scope of service covers physical examination, health assessment, individual health counselling and health education. Enrolled students of Student Health Service will be given an annual appointment at Lam Tin Student Health Service Centre. The SHS will provide a chartered bus service to and from the centre during school days for the participants. Parents will be requested to provide information or history about the student of his/her family to the SHSC. Therefore parents are required to accompany their children during treatment.

For Application, please complete the application form, together with the application fee (\$30 for Dental Care Service only) and return to the school office on or before 11th September 2018.
