Hand, foot and mouth disease in hostel and resume classes for the boarders

Dear Parents/Guardians :

Regarding the hand, foot and mouth disease (HFMD) condition announced on 16th September, now that all infected students staying in hostel have recovered and no new cases have been found within fourteen days, thus the school announced that all boarders will resume classes on 3rd October 2019.

The school has been thoroughly cleaned and disinfected during the suspension period. Our staffs will, as always, continue to adopt strict personal, hand and environmental hygiene practices against respiratory illnesses and other infectious diseases. Meanwhile, Parents/Guardians should continue to adopt following strict personal and environmental hygiene practices for students to prevent HFMD and other infectious diseases:

- ◆ Measure the body temperature of students before attending school. Please seek for the medical consultation as soon as possible when having symptoms, and also follow doctor's recommendation, to take rest at home and do not returns to school until recover.
- ◆ To pick up students not feeling well from school as fast as possible and seek for the medical consultation.
- ◆ Please also inform school general office/nursing station immediately, (Tel: 23862010/23862064) if the students are sick or have been admitted to hospital for surveillance.
