Dear Parents,

We understand that all carers, especially parents, spend a lot of time and effort in caring for people with special learning needs or intellectual disabilities, which involves both laughter and tears. Therefore, B.T.C.F.S. Yeung Yat Lam Memorial School, Rhenich Church Grace School and Tung Wan Mok Law Shui Wah School to organize the “Accompany You throughout My Life” (2021) Drawing Competition & Essay Writing Competition, to provide a platform for carers to express their feelings and give themselves some space to reflect, and more importantly, to give appreciation and recognition to the unconditional dedication without expecting any returns.

Apart from the opportunity for healing carers themselves and their sharing with each other, we also hope to draw more attention and support from the community to people with special learning needs or intellectual disabilities, through collecting and publishing the artworks of carers, so that people with special learning needs or intellectual disabilities could show their potential and give back to the society.

The Drawing Competition & Essay Writing Competition would be held for all carers (relatives or non-relatives) of persons with special learning needs or intellectual disabilities in Hong Kong. For example: grandparents, parents, siblings, domestic helpers, teaching staff and others. Entrants are free to express their experiences or feelings about caring for people with special learning needs or intellectual disabilities. Each entrant may **choose both** Drawing **and** Essay Writing for participation. There is one champion, one first runner-up, one second runner-up and ten merit prizes in this activity, and the organizer reserves the right to change the number of prizes at its discretion. The champion and runner-up winners will each receive a supermarket voucher, a certificate and a trophy, including, a \$1,000 supermarket voucher for the champion, an \$800 supermarket voucher for the first runner-up, a \$500 supermarket voucher for the second runner-up. In addition, to encourage participation, there also the earliest submission (individual) and the most enthusiastic participation (organisation) awards.
