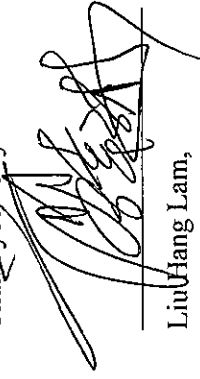
Remark:

2. All fees paid are non-refundable once confirmed.
3. If parents are unable to accompany their children to the outings due to individual problems, the school may not be able to arrange for your children to participate in the outings due to the safety of manpower coordination. (Note 4).
- All summer activities are whole school learning activities. Students who do not participate in summer activities and return to school, school will arrange

staffs for collective care of the students.

5. During the period of summer activities, the transportation of school bus to school and back home are as usual. (Please inform the driver by yourselves, if any students do not return to school during the summer activities.).
6. Air-conditioned tour buses and school buses will be arranged for all outing activities. If we are not able to make an appointment for rehabilitation bus, the vacancy of school buses will be arranged by the school according to the physical condition of the student. The transportation fee for accompanying parents are free (limited to two persons), and the third person will be charged at the student price. Students may apply for a fund waiver if necessary.
